

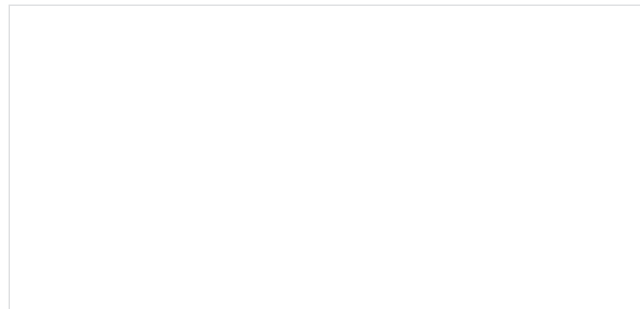

INSUFFICIENT VEINS MIGHT BE MORE THAN JUST A COSMETIC PROBLEM

It's no news to doctors that apart from being unsightly, varicose veins, also known as varices, can also be harmful to your health. They are usually caused by defective valves in veins. When the valves no longer work properly, blood pools in the veins becoming visible on the surface as ropey, blue varicose veins. The result may possibly be heavy, leaden feeling legs and swelling, throbbing, or brown discolourations of the skin in the ankle area. Venous insufficiency can furthermore lead to vein infections, thrombosis, ankle sores and ulcers.

MANY POSSIBLE CAUSES

Vein disorders are often genetic and occur for example due to an inherited weakness in connective tissue. Additional risk factors include a lack of physical activity, prolonged sitting or standing, obesity, and hormonal changes such as those caused by pregnancy or by taking birth control pills. Early diagnosis and treatment can relieve existing symptoms and prevent serious consequences.

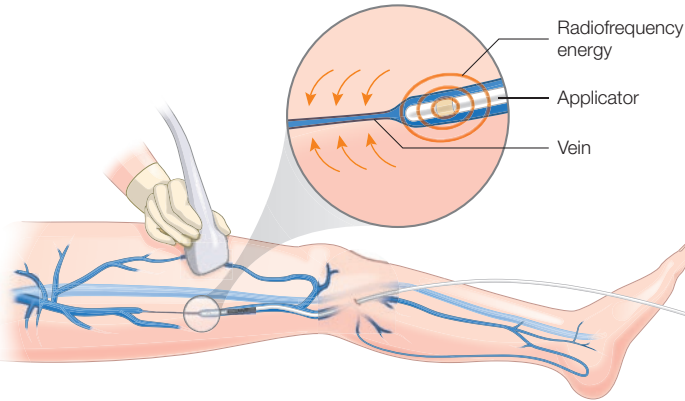

THE CELON RFITT METHOD: GENTLE, QUICK, SAFE



With the Celon RFITT method, your doctor uses an ultra-thin applicator to close the varicose vein, making it instantly invisible.

THE SMART, SIMPLE WAY TO HEALTHIER LEGS

The Celon RFITT method is a quick and safe treatment for varicose veins. Compared to conventional treatments, it is less painful as it avoids painful surgical removal of tissue. Instead, an ultra-thin applicator is inserted into the vein through a tiny cut in the skin. Hereafter, locally and precisely applied radiofrequency energy causes the vein to shrink and close up in a short time. Due to the intelligent control unit emitting exactly the necessary amount of energy to close the veins, the Celon RFITT method is as gentle as possible and efficiently minimizes unintended effects on surrounding tissue. Our patented radiofrequency-induced thermotherapy (RFITT) is a special and unique application of radiofrequency energy. Its success has proven the Celon RFITT method right: The veins are no longer visible after the treatment.

How safe is the Celon RFITT method?

The Celon RFITT method has been extensively clinically tested and was thereby proven to be a successful, safe treatment for varicose vein patients. Today, doctors' offices and hospitals around the world trust in Celon RFITT.

How long does the procedure take?

The treatment is an outpatient procedure and takes only about 30 minutes.

Is the Celon RFITT method painful?

Patients report feeling only little if any pain. The treatment is performed with either local or general anesthesia.

What should I do after the treatment?

Wearing compression stockings promotes the recovery, whereas bedrest is not required as you are mobile immediately after the treatment. The Celon RFITT method allows you to get back to work and your normal daily activities quickly. Besides, you can even resume your exercise routine and sports just about one week later.

Are there any side effects?

In isolated cases, patients may experience aching, mild swelling, and/or bruising along the vein.

What does the treatment cost?
